



Literatuurlijst – Towards a Radical Sisterhood

Voor het grootste gedeelte van de geschiedenis van het #feminisme, draaide de strijd voornamelijk om één type vrouw: de witte, heteroseksuele, cis-gender vrouw uit de (hoge) middenklasse. Inmiddels is dat voor een groot deel veranderd. Dankzij het #intersectioneel denken erkennen veel feministische bewegingen de meerlagigheid van onze identiteit.

Maar de #dekoloniale kritieken die overal opduiken wekken nieuwe vragen op: waarom denken we nog altijd in binaire tegenstellingen? Hoe transformeren we onze blik naar één die niet imperialistisch en eurocentrisch is? Hoe kunnen we vanuit onze verschillende identiteiten elkaars strijden versterken? En hoe pakken we dit aan in Vlaanderen en Nederland?
